

Italian Gardens of the Renaissance

The itinerary includes a visit to the Boboli Garden (subject to entrance fee, free entrance under 18 and over 65 years for EU citizens). The garden is located behind Pitti Palace, the last residence of the Medici family.

In addition to the Boboli Garden, which is considered the typical Italian garden of the Renaissance, it is also possible to visit the nearby Bardini garden, which has been recently reopened.

As an alternative, it is possible to visit the parks which surround the Medici villas in Castello (free entrance), a pleasant resort within a stone's throw from Florence.
